	<p style="text-align: center;">Autumn 1</p> <p>This is a six-week Unit of Work. All the learning is focused around one song: Hands, Feet, Heart. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise different styles of South African music.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spring 1</p> <p>This is a 6 week course. All the learning in this unit is focus on around one song: 'I Wanna Play in a Band'- a Rock song written especially for children, In this song they learn about singing and playing in an ensemble. Children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Summer 1</p> <p>The children will listen and appraise the Friendship Song and other songs about friendship: The children will learn and/or build on their knowledge and understanding about the interrelated dimensions of music.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Autumn 2</p> <p>This is a six-week Unit of Work that builds on previous learning. All the learning is focused around one song: Ho Ho Ho - a Christmas song. You will Listen & Appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and playing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spring 2</p> <p>This is a 6-week unit of work. All the learning in this unit is focus around one song: Zootime. The materials present an integrated approach to music where games, the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Summer 2</p> <p>This unit of work consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and beginnings of the Language of Music.</p>

The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, elements of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.), singing and playing instruments are all linked. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other Reggae songs.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Summer 1</p> <p>This is a Disco song about friendship, peace, hope and unity. It includes new Listen & Appraise apps; new progressive Warm-up Games, Flexible Games and improvisation resources, and a new compose tool.</p>

The learning is focused around exploring and developing playing skills through the glockenspiel.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spring 2</p> <p>This is a song about kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness.
